



2026-2027 Scholarship Application

Morrisville Presbyterian Church Offers Six Scholarships for the 2026-2027 School Year.

Graduating high school seniors and college students may be eligible for one of the scholarships offered by Morrisville Presbyterian Church (MPC) for the upcoming school year. Interested students may obtain a scholarship application [online](#).

The following three scholarships are available to anyone within the MPC Community - those associated with the church that may not be members but participate in the mission and ministry of MPC (such examples might be a Youth Club member, an active Food Center volunteer, etc.):

- **Helen Nicholas Borden Scholarship*** – Up to two scholarships are to be given to a deserving High School Senior or an undergraduate College student who demonstrates the values of hard work and perseverance. Preference to an MPC member but may be given to any student active in the life of MPC community. This is a need-based scholarship.
- **Birks Scholarship** – This scholarship originated in 1968 with an endowment in remembrance of William James Birks, who encouraged youth to pursue ministry. A scholarship is available to undergraduate or graduate students following a course of study in ministry. This scholarship is available to MPC members and those in the MPC community.
- **Clara Burgess Scholarship*** – This scholarship was created in 1948 by the Women's Guild in memory of Clara. Scholarships are available to an undergraduate student with financial need. The scholarship is available to members of MPC members and those within the MPC community.

The following are available to MPC members only:

- **Roberts Scholarship** – A scholarship available to undergraduate or graduate students following a course of study in medicine or ministry. This scholarship was created in 1987 by the sister of Mary Carver Roberts and is available to MPC Members.
- **Patti Jane Reeves Scholarship** – A scholarship awarded to a graduating high school senior who has shown academic excellence, service to community, participation in the life of the church and academic excellence. The scholarship is available to MPC members.
- **McClaren*** – This scholarship was created in 1970 for children with financial need of MPC members.

***Note: Need based scholarships require** Government FAFSA Score (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) regardless if you qualify for FAFSA. MPC uses FAFSA data to determine relative need.
